

1. Visit www.baml.com/globalcardaccess. Log in with the User ID and Password you set up when you retrieved the PIN associated with your University credit card. (First-time user? [View registration instructions](#).)
2. Select **Manage Alerts**.
3. **Contacts** tab: Select **Text** from the Contact Type dropdown menu (**Voice** and **Email** are also available). Enter your mobile phone number and click Save.
